

## Pay Personal Property Taxes The Easy Way Online

The Falls Church City Treasurer's Office now offers residents an easy and convenient method to view and pay personal property invoices online; just visit the City web site at [www.fallschurchva.gov](http://www.fallschurchva.gov). (Note: due to a printing error, the web site address included in tax bills mailed last week was incorrect.)

Online bill pay is:

- **Fast and easy.** Quick, simple, easier and cheaper than writing and mailing checks, and with online bill pay you will receive an email confirming that your payment has been accepted.
- **Safe and secure.** Information is kept confidential and is 100% secure, backed by the highest standards in security.
- **Eco-friendly.** Paying online reduces paper use and is an easy way to help the environment. You'll save natural resources like trees, and gas, and reduce your carbon footprint.

Phase I of the online bill pay gives citizens access to view and pay personal property tax bills online. Over the next few months, citizens will be able to access and pay City of Falls Church real estate tax bills, water bills, parking tickets, dog licenses and recreation fees.
